<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Sort things in order according to size.</li><li>- Continue a given pattern with an ABC base.</li><li>- Classify by three attributes: size, shape, and color.</li><li>- Temporal orientation: Identify, compare, and sequence three events.</li><li>- Compare the quantity of two sets of things using “more,” “less,” and “same as”.</li><li>- Count to 20.</li><li>- Read and write numbers to 10.</li><li>- Compare and order numbers to 10.</li><li>- Name parts that form the whole in quantity (Ex, 3 and 2 make 5)</li><li>- Solve simple addition word problems to 10.</li></ul>

## 3. English

Contents
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Vocabulary about animals, family, neighborhood, jobs, colors, emotions, body parts, numbers from 1 to 10</li><li>- Personal Pronouns: he/she, they, is/are.</li><li>- Prepositions of place (in, on, under, over, in front of, behind, next to, between).</li><li>- Verbs: Like, see, have,</li><li>- Phonemic awareness: Recognizes initial, middle, and ending sounds in a word.</li><li>- Phonics: Knows the sounds /s/, /a/, /t/, /p/, /i/, /n/, /m/, /d/, /g/, /o/, /k/, /e/, /u/, /r/, /h/, /b/, /f/, /l/, /j/, /v/, /w/, /ks/, /y/, /z/.</li><li>- Identify and read sight words: I, the, in, at, see, he, she, it, to, and,</li><li>- Identify and read CVC words like. cup, cat, sit, set, red, dog, pen, pin, (Consonant, vowel, consonant words.)</li><li>- Blending words.</li><li>- Segmenting words.</li></ul>
